MSDS and Hazard Communication

The U.S. Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) advises that electrical components of the type manufactured by IHI and other manufactures are not subject to the Hazard Communication standard as it relates to providing Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS).

OSHA advises that products of this type meet the definition of an "Article" as defined in 1910.1200 Hazard Communication Standard, Section (b), (6) and Section (c) definitions.

"Article" means a manufactured item: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent, in whole or in part, upon the shape or design during end use; and (iii) which does not release or otherwise result in exposure to a hazardous chemical under normal conditions of use."
