Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) **Compliance Statement**

The European Union passed the **Restriction of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directive** (2002/95/EC) into law as of 27 January 2003.

This directive prohibits the sale of new electrical and electronic equipment that contains threshold quantities of certain substances deemed detrimental to human health and the environment. The effective date for compliance is 1 July 2006.

There are six major hazardous materials subject to the RoHS directive.

| <u>Substance</u> | <u>Threshold Limit</u> |

| Lead | <0.1%w (<1000 ppm) |
| Mercury | <0.1%w (<1000 ppm) |
| Cadmium | <0.01%w (<100 ppm) |
| Hexavalent Chrome (Cr+6) | <0.1%w (<1000 ppm) |
| PBB (Polybrominated Biphenyl) | <0.1%w (<1000 ppm) |
| PBDE (Polybrominated Diphenyl Ether) | <0.1%w (<1000 ppm) |
| DecaBDE(Polybrominated Diphenylethers) | <0.1%w(<1000 ppm)- |
